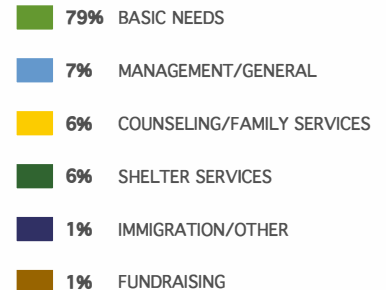
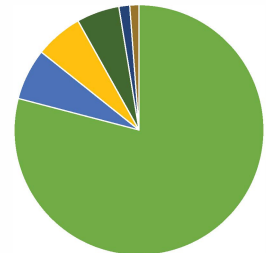
### REVENUE
